The DfE's Recruitment and Retention strategy, published in January 2019, commits to improving support for all teachers, ensuring that they receive high quality training and development at every stage of their career – from Initial Teacher Training (ITT) through to leadership qualifications. Central to this are the ITT Core Content and Early Career Frameworks, which set out an entitlement to new, evidence-based support and training over the first three or more years of a teacher's career, as well as support for their mentors.
